

## CONSENT FORM FOR REGISTERING A VEHICLE TO A REGISTERED CUSTOMER ACCOUNT

This Consent Form for Registering a Vehicle to a Registered Customer Account is to be used by: (i) the holder of a customer account in good standing who wishes to register a vehicle to his/her active A25 customer account, when said vehicle is not registered in his/her name; and (ii) the person in whose name the vehicle to be added to the customer account is registered.

Each of the customer account holder and the person in whose name the vehicle to be added is registered acknowledges that he/she has read carefully and understands the Terms and Conditions of Use of the A25 THE SMART LINK toll system and agrees to be bound by them.

**By signing this form, the customer account holder agrees to the following:**

- To add the vehicle in question to his/her customer account, when said vehicle was registered with the SAAQ under another person's name;
- To assume responsibility for toll fees charged for crossings by said vehicle;
- To bear all applicable extra charges associated with the customer account and/or the added vehicle;
- The prepaid amount required for adding the vehicle will be paid using the current mode of payment for the customer account concerned.

**The person in whose name the vehicle is registered represents the following:**

- The vehicle is registered in his/her name at the SAAQ;
- He/she accepts that information concerning his/her vehicle, bridge crossings and information held by the SAAQ be used for the purposes of registration and administration of the customer account held by the account holder and that such information be made available to the account holder;
- There is no outstanding unpaid crossing of the A25 Bridge in his/her name;
- He/she accepts to pay amounts invoiced for any bridge crossing by his/her vehicle prior to being added to the customer account and after the closing of the account, in accordance with the rate schedule available on the A25 website.

**Both parties agree to the following:**

- Registering a vehicle to a customer account requires a sufficient credit balance to pay for tolls, administration fees and interest charges associated with the use the A25 Bridge for all vehicles registered to the customer account in question;
- The consent for registering a vehicle to an account ends automatically in the event of a negative account balance and/or when such consent is withdrawn;
- A request for the consent to be withdrawn can be submitted in writing to the A25 Customer Service by the holder of the customer account or by the person in whose name the vehicle is registered;
- In such cases, any use of the A25 Bridge by the person in whose name the vehicle is registered will be subject to the toll rates applied to users without a customer account. Information concerning current fees and charges is available on the A25 website.;
- The customer account holder continues to be responsible for any access to the customer account;
- If the customer account holder wishes to give access to his/her account to the person in whose name the vehicle is registered, a formal request must be submitted to the A25 Customer Service to add a name to the account;
- The vehicle being added to the customer account must continue to be registered with the SAAQ under the same name as long as the name of the person concerned appears in the customer account;
- Failing this, the consent will be automatically withdrawn by A25;
- In the event of the suspension and/or closing of the account, the customer account holder must inform the person in whose name the vehicle is registered.

If Concession A25 L.P. ("CA25") accepts your registration, both parties consent to be bound by the terms and conditions above and the Terms and Conditions of Use of the A25 THE SMART LINK, which are available on the A25 website.

CA25 reserves the right to reject any request to register a vehicle to the A25 THE SMART LINK toll system or to apply certain conditions to such registration.
